Over the course of their visit, the assessors spent time observing classroom learning, exploring our school facilities, and reviewing our curriculum and documentation. They also conducted interviews with students, teachers, leadership and parents to gain a well-rounded understanding of daily life at our school.

The team commented on the positive and nurturing learning environment, as well as the enthusiasm, happiness and inquisitiveness of our students. They were also interested in how our school balances academic learning with creativity, nature, and cultural appreciation. We are now waiting for the final report and feel optimistic about the outcome. As soon as we receive official confirmation, we will share the results with our school community.
